Donna presented her plan for five 18-hour long days, including the four hours each day for Conference and final Celebration for ARTS' birthday/Founders Day, etc. By scheduling as many meetings as possible, idea is to reach as many people as possible. Feedback included:

- This seems like a lot of hours
- Attendance might be better if one day, instead of five
- Could be spreading ourselves thin, including technical support, and exhausting delegates
- Perhaps 3-4 hours before and after each Conference session rather than seven
- Reminder that we've never done on a Conference or Convention online before
- Perhaps have the Conference as scheduled, and a Convention the following weekend
- Perhaps only one long day of a Convention before and after the four-hour birthday and Abby celebration

MOTION: Conference and Convention Planning Committees will put together a survey to send to the Fellowship with four options presented: 1) As Donna proposed with five 18-

	hour days 2) Four days of Conference only as scheduled, with one day of Conference on the fifth day 3) Five days totalling 6-8 hours split between Conference and Convention 4) hold the Conference as scheduled, and hold a Convention the following weekend.
