This committee is coming together to discover the resource of talents and skills within our fellowship. Our focus is Tradition 5: *Each group has but one primary purpose – to carry its message to the artist who still suffers*. Our purpose is to enable projects that make A.R.T.S. Anonymous visible to those we have not yet reached. The 12 Traditions and the 12 Concepts of Service will guide how to best meet this need to carry the message.

What the committee contributes to the Fellowship:

The opportunity to discover the talents, skills, and creativity of members within our Fellowship.

The opportunity to actively support Tradition 5.

A resource to support projects that wish to bring A.R.T.S. Anonymous visible to the struggling artist.

A survey that identifies what a life's experience amasses for each a member regarding skills, talents, and a well of creative ideas.

What actions this committee is planning to take:

Meet on a regular basis.

Create a survey that identifies the skills, and creative talents of each survey participant.

Present the survey to an approval process. (Board)

Invite the members of our fellowship to participate in the survey.

Distribute the survey to the fellowship.

Collect and organize the data to present to the conference.

Repeat this process annually to include new members.

What this committee hopes to achieve, if voted in by the Conference:

Survey assessments may serve as a source to seek out the skills, talents, and creative ideas required for a project to evolve toward implementation. Such projects are inspired to meet our primary purpose as expressed in Tradition 5, such as: a public service announcement, 30 second Video clips, social media, a book of member stories, or a blog. The hope is that these projects may be realized when talented members from our fellowship gather and resource one another to get there.

Continued regular updates to the survey, and its implementation may serve for A.R.T.S. Anonymous for years to come.
